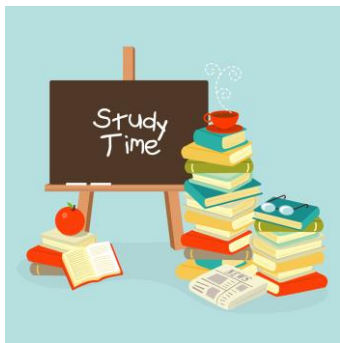


# Welcome to Year 2 Curriculum Newsletter for the Summer term 2017

## Literacy

### Narrative

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## Numeracy

- Fast recall of 2, 5 and 10 times table facts and associated division facts
- Add coins and give change from £5.00
- Choose and use appropriate operations and calculation strategies to solve one step, then two step word problems.
- Estimate, measure and compare weights, choosing and using suitable standard units.
- Estimate, measure then compare length and distance using metres and centimetres
- Fractions of shapes and amounts: halves, quarters, thirds, three quarters
- Telling the time to the nearest 5 minutes
- Collecting and displaying information on pictograms, bar charts and Carroll diagrams
