

- * Shape: identifying horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular lines
- * Measuring using millilitres and litres
- * Use kg and g to measure and compare masses.
- * Read, write, order and round two-digit and three-digit numbers
- * Multiplication and division problems
- * Mental addition and subtraction of three-digit numbers and 1s, 10s and 100s
- * Addition and subtraction of two-digit and three-digit numbers using columns
- * Addition and subtraction of two and three-digit numbers using number lines and columns
- * Multiplication and division problems: written methods
- * Short multiplication and division, using informal and standard methods
- * Fractions: equivalence, addition and subtraction within 1, finding tenths
- * Read and write time using 12 and 24 hour clock
