The purpose of this letter is to give you information regarding what your child will be learning in the Summer term.

Topics

Electricity (Science)

Living Things and Their Habitats (Science)

The Anglo-Saxons (History)

Mosaic (Art)

The Romans (History)



English

Children will be looking at a variety of different text types including:

Fiction; Stories which raise issues and dilemmas and Stories from other cultures and traditions

Non-Fiction; persuasive writing.

They will also be revisiting using pronouns to avoid repetition, punctuating direct speech and using conjunctions.

Maths

The topics that Year 4 will be working on in Maths this term are:

Decimals, money, time, statistics, position and direction and properties of shape.

Year 4 children are expected to be able to tell the time to the nearest minute on an analogue and digital clock and to be able to convert between 12 and 24-hour time.

PE

Our topics in PE are; Athletics, Striking and Fielding, Dance and Orienteering.

Bikeability

On Tuesday 21st May, we have tutors from Cycle Safe coming to school to give free Cycle Safety training to children in Year 4. This will take place in the morning.

In order to take part in the training, children must have a safe bike with working brakes. They must also be able to ride it competently and have returned their permission slip.
