What will school look like?

All children in school will stay within their own classrooms as they did before Christmas. Each class will be a 'Bubble' and there will be little or no contact between the Bubbles. Your child will come into contact with only a limited number of adults.

Which entrances should we use and what time should we arrive? Siblings can be dropped off and picked up at the earlier time.

Reception

Pupils in Reception will be taught by Mrs. Pearson in the Reception classroom.

Entrance/ Exit through the Main Entrance.

Arrive 9.00am. Collect 3.15pm

Year 1

Pupils in Year 1 will be taught by Miss Platt and Mrs. Tetlow in the Year 1 classroom.







Entrance/ Exit through the classroom door in Year 1. Arrive 8.40am. Collect 2.55pm

Year 2

Pupils in Year 2 will be taught by Mrs. Joyce in the Year 2 classroom. Entrance/ Exit through the classroom door in Year 2 (through gate at the side of the school). Arrive 8.50am. Collect 3.05pm

Year 3

Pupils in Year 3 will be taught by Mrs. Charnley in the Year 3 classroom. Entrance/ Exit through the Main Entrance. Arrive 8.40am. Collect 2.55pm

Year 4

Pupils in Years 4 will be taught by Miss Thomas in the Year 4 classroom. Entrance/ Exit through the Junior gate. Arrive 8.50am. Collect 3.05pm.

Year 5

Pupils in Years 5 will be taught by Miss Rooney in the Year 5 classroom. Entrance/ Exit through the Junior gate. Arrive 9.00am. Collect 3.15pm.

Year 6

Pupils in Years 6 will be taught by Mrs. Adamson in the Year 6 classroom. Entrance/ Exit through the Junior gate. Arrive 8.40am. Collect 2.55pm.

What do we ask of parents bringing pupils to school?

Only one parent to bring pupils to school. Teachers and teaching assistants will meet the pupils at the gate or door in order to hand sanitise them.

What should pupils wear?

• The children will need to come in their full school uniform, including black school shoes.

What will pupils need to bring with them?

- No book bags can be brought into school as we will not be able to change reading books please continue to use the Oxford Owl website as well as your own reading books from home.
- The children must bring a named water bottle in from home. This will remain on the child's work station. The water bottles will be sent home for washing every day, **please ensure these bottles are clearly labelled.**
- Pupils may bring their own packet of disposable tissues and hand sanitiser if they wish. Please label both.

Will there be Before and After School Facility and Extra Curricular Activities?

- There will be no extra-curricular activities.
- Please contact the individual providers of before and After School Care to find out the details for their availability.

All of the plans we have informed you of in this letter remain subject to change if the Government, Local Authority or Teaching Unions recommend a different course of action, at which point we will change our plans accordingly and communicate with you once we have considered the recommendation fully.
