Dear Parents,

Pupils Learning at Home

Thank you all for your patience and understanding today, I really never thought we would be back in this position. As we did last time I know we will all work together to try to make the best out of this very difficult situation.

Numbers of key worker children is at a high level and until we receive further guidance unfortunately we cannot offer any further places. We await further guidance from the Government and this may affect our plans going forward.

What will home learning look like?

Those pupils who are staying at home the learning will be on the website. Again the work the children will be set in school will be exactly the same as the work set for children at home. The children's work will be updated regularly and you can find a timetable and activities for each day on your child's class page. At https://www.buckstones.oldham.sch.uk/ click on School Life and then your child's class page.

What activities will be provided via the website?

- Daily maths. lessons following on/mirroring the maths. being covered in the classroom.
- Daily English lessons following on/mirroring the English being covered in the classroom. This will include spelling, grammar, writing and reading and phonics for Key Stage 1.
- Daily topic task(s) these will be lessons your child would have had in class this term which can be most easily adapted to remote learning.
- 1:1 support if your child receives 1:1 support and they are isolating, a more bespoke programme of support will be set up.
